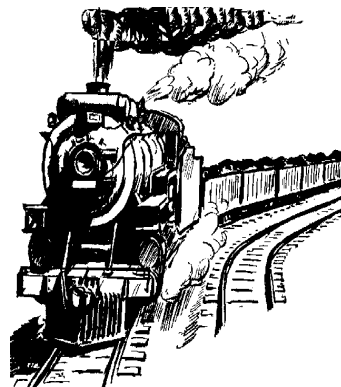
& SUNDAY, SEP 5, 2004

The Society has organized a field trip to Cranbrook and area for Saturday and Sunday of the Labour Day Weekend. We'll leave Calgary by motor coach on Saturday, with stops at the Bellevue Mine and Leitch Collieries on our way to Cranbrook, where we will tour the Canadian Museum of Rail Travel and attend a barbeque before checking in at the Prestige Rocky Mountain Resort and Convention Centre for the evening. We also expect to see CPR #2816 in steam leaving Cranbrook at 4:30 that afternoon.

On Sunday morning we will head to Kimberley to ride the tramway at the Sullivan mine before heading over to Fort Steele for lunch, a tour of the museum, and another train ride. After our visit there, we'll head north on our way back to Calgary, with an expected arrival time of 7:00 pm.
