## SUPERTRAIN 2022 – Volunteers Survey

### SUPERTRAIN 2022 Planning Call for Volunteers

We presented the SUPERTRAIN 2022 plan at the AGM and it has been well received by the attendees. We thank the members present at the AGM for their overwhelming support. The Saturday Gala is cancelled for 2022, and the Kids Play Area will also be closed. The layout judging is on, but we have cancelled the people’s choice vote. The show dates are April 9-10, 2022.

At the time of this publication, the COVID regulations for a show like SUPERTRAIN are that the exhibitors, volunteers, and visitors must be double-vaccinated, and must wear a mask at all times inside the premise. Since there are other tenants at the Genesis Centre, their staff are responsible for checking the vaccination status at their doors, and it will be a joint effort to enforce the mask requirement on the floor, which means we need more security volunteers.

The Genesis Centre has recently put us in contact with their AHS advisor, and we will work with him to ensure the rules and regulations are respected and the show is secured for everybody. More details to come on that and as the pandemic situation evolves.

One of the highest risks identified is not to have enough volunteers to work at the show. It was already a problem before the pandemic, and we expect it to be worse for the upcoming show. We will soon email the members and prior volunteers a survey and we ask that everyone participate and gives their honest answers. There is no bad answer, and the survey will be anonymous. This is not a call for volunteers yet, this will happen later in January.
