

Alberta Free-mo 2024 Big Valley Alberta – After Action Summary

Calgary Free-mo held its annual Alberta Free-mo setup at Big Valley from 15 – 18 August. It was a relatively modest setup – 55 Free-mo modules, total 384 feet, coming from British Columbia, Saskatchewan, and Alberta. Setup started 10:00 Thursday 15th and completed by early evening; trains ran 24 hours a day until tear down Sunday at 16:00. The setup ran loop to loop with a branch to a yard used for setting up trains. There were three sections of double track separated by two sections of single track to keep operators interested. Besides the full participants present from start of setup to end of tear down, some operators came for a shorter time to run their trains. Some children and grandchildren of participants ran trains as well – often better than their elders!!. The setup ran well with the usual gremlins corrected fairly quickly.

Social aspects of these setups are always satisfying – seeing old friends and meeting new ones. The traditional Saturday 'Bring your own meat' Pot Luck overflowed with delicious food, enough to have some left over for Sunday lunch. The Village of Big Valley was, as always, very cooperative in hosting us, including the many participants who camped on site.

As is normal for these setups, Alberta Prairie Railway scheduled trips to Big Valley to coincide with our presence there. Visitors from the train were amazed at the scale of the setup and the detail of the modules, and there was no shortage of moving trains to catch the eye.
