

CPKC Movie Night at the Royal Canadian Pavilion

Photo above is just some of the heavy metal that took CP 2816 from Calgary to Mexico City and home again last year in celebration of the CP and KCS merger. CPKC had a Movie Night for the CMRS members on February 7 2025 at the Royal Canadian Pavilion at CPKC Ogden yards.

This was an excellent opportunity to see "Pulse of the Continent: Final Spike Steam Tour" and "Rocky Mountain Express" movies alongside of 2816. *Afterwards Adam Meeks, Jonathan Morris, Peter Boyle, Jim Scott and Matt Cummins* took questions from the crowd. What was so impressive was the amount of work along with logistics that had to be arranged for this trip. One example was they had to get 16 tank cars of water into Mexico as they had no water for 2816 because there was such a water shortage. CP 2816 carried 600 tons of water with her, but drought conditions along with poor water quality meant having the tank cars strategically placed from Southern Texas to Mexico City. The use of a small Honda pump and an early alarm set at 3:00 am started the Fireman's day to fill the tenders.

Crew also talked about the work on tearing 2816 down and rebuilding again to be ready for the Final Spike Steam Tour. CMRS thanks the many tradesmen and crews that took this project on and the successful run to Mexico and back again.
