Calgary Model Trainmen and Calgary Free-mo got together over the Christmas and New Year's Holidays for this Open House Run and built a very large layout combining modules (CFM) and a permanent set up (CMT). A particular highlight was the very large CMT helix that was completed. The photo taken does not do it justice as it stands about 7 feet high. The third level of the layout will be finished next year to give more mainline length.

CFM had 15 modules set up in the adjacent room. All the legs had to be lengthened by 8" from 42"-50". CFM did this by adding a notched extension to their existing legs, about 60 in total. The CMT layout that the club takes to shows etc. ties into the helix. At the mid point of the helix it takes off and runs along the wall to the CFM set up. CMT (at 58") built a ramp about 15 feet long so that the two clubs could join up at the 50" elevation.

The day we visited they had 4 trains running through the whole setup with lots of detailed modules. I hope you had a chance to visit the Open House. They are booked for around the same time next December 2025, so stay tuned.


