The fish plant is kitbashed from a Hamilton's Dinghies kit (Campbell Scale Models) and sits on the Norm's Landing Fishing Pier (also Campbell Scale Models). The fishing tug (a Great Lakes term for fishing boats) was kitbashed from a Kibri tug kit.
