TSUJI is a Japanese HO scale (1/80) proto-freelanced layout. Japanese HO rolling stock is 1/80 scale to simulate the comparative size of the prototype's 3 foot 6 inch narrow gauge track. TSUJI takes inspiration from the JR Otsuka station on the Yamanote line. While some liberties were taken for the physical space and track layouts, the overall layout is meant to evoke the real location, and broadly the northern area of Tokyo.

Bench work is largely built to North American Free-Mo spec. Layout operates a mix of DC and Digitrax DCC. Sound equipped rolling stock uses ESU decoders with custom files. The moving auto mobile system is a Faller car system

SUPERTRAIN REPORT

In planning and organizing an event as large and complex as SUPERTRAIN, there are always a few things that are totally out of the control of the Committee. One of these is the weather. This year, Mother Nature wasn't as kind to us as in previous years, with a cold wind making move-in on Friday downright unpleasant. The snow on the ground over the weekend may also have influenced some potential guests to stay home. However, the 10,464 people who did venture out were not disappointed by what they came to see.

The total admissions were about 1,900 people fewer than in 2025.

The number of exhibits and floor area used were about 20% more than last year, making it the biggest SUPERTRAIN ever. We had vendors, layouts, and displays literally from coast to coast. Everyone I talked to seemed to be happy with the public's response. The food concession right on the show floor was a popular addition. Improved signage was a big help, and the return of a well-produced Show Guide was appreciated by all. The move-in procedures were streamlined this year, and almost every exhibitor commented on how much better it worked. Move-out was still a bit chaotic, but even so, the last exhibitor was out of the Oval by 8:45pm Sunday evening, close to the best time ever.

Final tallying of the financial results is still on-going but it is safe to say that SUPERTRAIN 2026 was successful money-wise. Payouts to hobby exhibits will be going out toward the end of the month. Full financial results will be reported to the CMRS membership at the Fall AGM.

Please join me in thanking the dedicated volunteers who make SUPERTRAIN such a success. CMRS members, spouses, Scouts, Guides, and students from Churchill High School all contributed countless hours before, during, and after the show. SUPERTRAIN is truly envied by shows in other locations for the volunteer spirit that we enjoy.

Now, while we catch our breath over the summer, it won't be long before planning begins for SUPERTRAIN 2027, to be held at the Olympic Oval on April 24-25, 2027.
